



Meet Pastor Ken Albright



Grace and Glory, the only Lutheran church in Fluvanna County, has appointed its first, full-time minister, the Rev. Kenneth W. Albright, a North Carolina native with 12 years experience in both Tennessee and Georgia. Pastor Albright, most recently served for seven years as pastor of St. Luke Lutheran Church in McDonough, GA, a suburb of Atlanta.

Pastor Albright, who was ordained in 1994, holds a Bachelor's degree in Christian Education from Lenoir-Rhyne College in Hickory, NC and a Master of Divinity degree from Lutheran Theological Southern Seminary in Columbia, SC.

During his years serving a congregation in Georgia, Pastor Albright served on the board of Sacred Journey Hospice Foundation and as a volunteer chaplain for the local hospice. He supported the work of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America (ELCA) in the area of World Hunger and was active in launching a week-long mission trip through Lutheran Disaster Response to those affected by Hurricane Katrina in Mississippi.

Pastor Albright and his wife, Charlotte, have two daughters. The family resides at Lake Monticello.
