

## **Lesson Plan Summary Topic Schedule**

### **Lord, when did we see you...in Fluvanna?**

**Scripture Focus: Matthew 25: 31-46 --“Truly I tell you as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me.”**

**Kickoff Speaker: June 12**

Rev. Doug Smith—Director for Virginia Interfaith Center for Public Policy

Addressing: What issues in the most recent and upcoming legislature affect Fluvanna residents most directly? What Scriptures have inspired and continue to inspire him to do the work of justice and advocacy in Virginia? What would he envision a small, rural churches like Grace and Glory doing to make a big impact on their community?

**Week One: June 19 Sick—**

This week could focus on Health issues in our county that affect the poor.

**Week Two: June 26 Thirsty—**

This week could focus on water issues in Fluvanna. Is lack of clean or adequate drinking water an issue here? What are the consequences of our pumping so much water from the Rivanna? Are there people who cannot pay their excessive water/sewer rates at Lake Monticello?

**Week Three: July 3 Stranger—**

This week could focus on the drug and crime element in Fluvanna. Where are the greatest concerns in the county? In the schools? What programs and people are needed to combat the problems?

**Week Four: July 10 In prison—**

This week could focus on the needs of the women institutionalized at the Fluvanna Women’s Corrections Center. What are their physical needs; emotional/spiritual needs; What support do their staff need?

**Week Five: July 17 Hungry—**

This week could focus on the hunger facts in Fluvanna, current measures to address them, and what God may be calling us to do about the unmet needs.

**Week Six: July 24 Naked—**

This week could focus on poverty—the broadening gap between the haves and the have nots. What percentage of residents live at/below poverty level. What is a true “living wage” in Fluvanna county?
